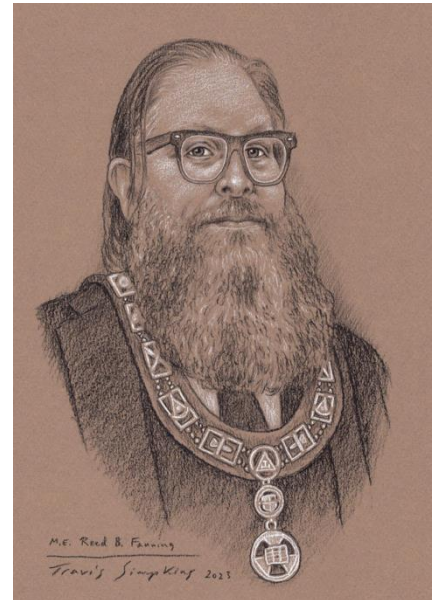


Reed Fanning

Candidate For General Grand King

Reed B. Fanning, Jr. was born January 31st, 1973, to Reed Berrett Fanning Sr. and Vicki Lynn Fanning in Ogden, Utah. As the child of a member of the military, he attended various schools around the country. Sir Knight Fanning attended Highland High School in Pocatello, Idaho. He enlisted in his Junior year and was off to serve in the Army the day after he graduated. He made Eagle Scout when he was 14 and has held civic positions in his community, such as President of his Homeowners Association Board, and as an Executive Board Member for two International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE) unions for nineteen years.



In his civilian life, Companion Fanning has worked as a rigger, set lighting technician, and flyman in the entertainment industry for most of his career.

Companion Fanning started his Masonic Career in April of 2002. He was raised to the sublime degree of a Master Mason in February of 2003 in Acacia Lodge No. 17 in Salt Lake City. He served as Master of Lodge Alba No. 315 in 2017 in West Seattle, WA. His Masonic Lodge memberships also include Mt. Moriah Lodge No. 2 and an Honorary membership in East Denver No. 160 in Denver, CO. Companion Fanning is also active in The Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite Valley of Salt Lake, where he has served as Wise Master in the Jordan Lodge of Perfection. He also served as Venerated Chieftain of the Scots Guard. He was honored in 2009 with the rank of Knight Commander Court Honor and is a Past President of the KCCH

Club. He is a member of El Kalah Shrine Temple in Salt Lake and Azim Grotto in the Bronx, New York. He is a founding member of the Masonic Society and served on the Board of Directors. He is a member of the Grand College of Rites. He is a member of Colorado College and Idaho College Societas Rosicruciana in Civitatibus Foederatis, where he has been elevated to grade of Magister VII°.

Companion Fanning is a member of the Utah No. 1 York Rite Bodies. He is a Past Excellent High Priest of Ontario Chapter No. 3, Royal Arch Masons (2009); Past Illustrious Master of Daly Council No. 5, Cryptic Masons (2010); and Past Commander of Malta Commandery No. 3, Knights Templar (2009). He is also serving as the Right Worshipful Master of Keystone No. 00, Mark Master Masons Lodge, where he was a charter member.

Companion Fanning served as Thrice Illustrious Master of the Thrice Illustrious Master's Order of the Silver Trowel from (2019-2021); Most Excellent President of the Order of Anointed High Priests of Melchizedek (2021-2022)

Companion Fanning served as Most Illustrious Grand Master of Utah for the term of 2020-2021. He served as the Very Puissant Ambassador to Utah for the General Grand Council of Cryptic Masons International for 2020-2023. He is currently serving the General Grand Chapter Royal Arch Masons International as General Grand Scribe.

Companion Fanning served as the Right Eminent Grand Commander for the state of Utah in 2024. Presided as the Excellent President of the Past Commanders Association of Utah (2022-2023). He is also a member of the Sovereign Order of Knights Preceptor, as well as the Knights Crusader of the Cross.

Companion Fanning served as the Excellent Chief of Great Chiefs' Council of Knight Masons in 2014. He served as Worshipful Master of Salish Court No.96, Masonic Order of Athelstan, in 2018. Companion Fanning is a member of the Worshipful Society of Free Masons, Rough Masons, Wallers, Slaters, Paviers, Plasterers, and Bricklayers and holds the rank of IV°. He belongs to two Quarry

Assemblages, Solar White in North Carolina and Samuel G. Wilkeson in Utah. Companion Fanning is a Past Sovereign Master of the Grand Masters Council of the Allied Masonic Degrees, where he served as Venerable Master (2012). He has been the Grand Superintendent of the Rocky Mountain region for the AMD since 2021. He also holds the Knight Grand Cross for the Red Branch of Erie and is a 5th Grand Royal Order of the Masonic Knights of the Scarlet Cord. Companion Fanning is a member of Utah Priory No. 47 KYCH, where he served as Prior in 2023-2024. He is also a member of The Masonic Order Pilgrims Preceptor in Mayflower Conclave No. 8. He is a member of two York Rite Colleges, Tri-Valley No. 178 and Camp Floyd No. 190. He is currently the Deputy Governor for Camp Floyd in Utah. Received the Order of the Purple Cross in 2025. He is a Holy Royal Arch Knight Templar Priest in Tabernacle A and was honored to receive the Order of Holy Wisdom in 2022. Companion Fanning is a member of three Chapels of the Order of St. Thomas of Acon: Trinity No. 2, Intermountain No.27, and Mount Nebo No. 34. He is a Past Worthy Master and a Past Grand Herald and served as Provincial Registrar for the Province of the Northwest.

Companion Fanning has served the York Rite with a zeal for betterment of the Craft. His joy for Masonry can be seen wherever he goes. The true love of the Craft is in his heart and has been spread across our beautiful Country in every jurisdiction he has visited. His only hope is to serve without the hope of fee or reward.
